MobyMax

Moby Max is an awesome educational tool that incorporates Math and Language Arts. ALA has been using both of these programs for the past two years. At the end of the year, students will take an end of level assessment for both language arts and math. MobyMax then assigns students lessons to help them focus on areas that may be lacking in their knowledge. MobyMax is an excellent tool to keep students from falling behind in the summer months. MobyMax is centered on K-8th core content.

ALEKS

This program has been used in the secondary for several years and will be available for student use throughout the summer. When the students are transferred into a new class (this will be done at the beginning of summer), a comprehensive assessment is triggered that every student takes in order to recalibrate what their current knowledge level is for that content. Then they begin to work through their pie and their goal of 100%.

Incentives for Summer Efforts
