



Pathway: Cabinetmaking/Millwork

Get the Facts:

Cabinetmakers cut, shape, and assemble wooden articles or set up and operate a variety of woodworking machines, such as power saws and jointers to surface, cut, or shape lumber or to fabricate parts for wood products.

Furniture Finishers shape, finish, and refinish damaged, worn, or used furniture or new high- grade furniture to specified color or finish.

Workforce Trends:

Employment of Cabinetmakers and Furniture Finishers is projected to GROW 4% from 2014 to 2024.

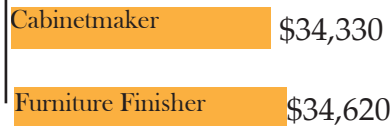
Those who have advanced skills, including the ability to use computer-controlled machinery and good math skills should have the best job opportunities.
